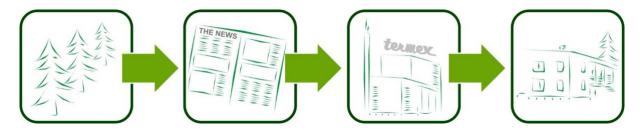

2. PRODUCT INFORMATION

Product description

The declaration is made for loose-fill cellulose insulation, Termex, which is manufactured in two different locations, in Saarijärvi, Finland and Bialogard, Poland. Wastepaper is mixed with boric acid and organic salt to produce blown-in thermal insulation.



Termex can be used as insulation in horizontal, vertical and inclined spaces. It is installed with a blowing equipment.

3. SCOPE OF LIFE CYCLE ASSESSMENT

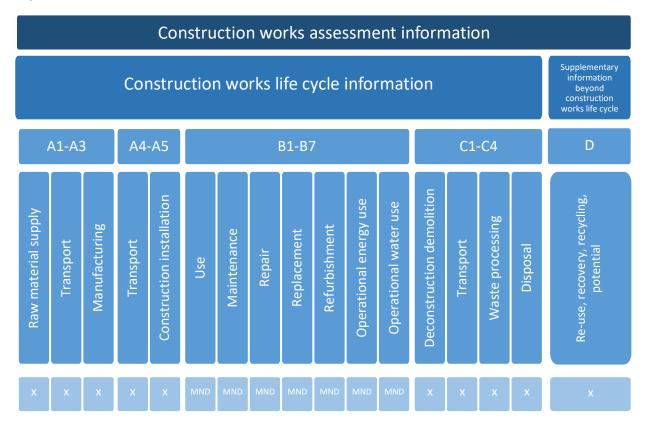


Figure 1. Modules in life cycle assessment of construction works. Modules included on this EPD are marked with x and MND = Module not included.

This EPD covers cradle to gate, A1-A5 with options, modules C1-C4 and D, as shown in the Figure 1.

Cut-off criteria

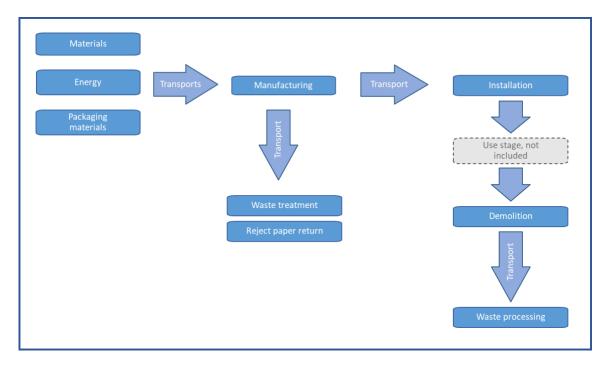
Data for A1-A5 and C1-C4 and additional information on scenarios in Module D have been collected. Modules A1 to A3 include all the raw materials used, energy production (electricity, heat and fuels), including primary production and processing of raw materials and fuels and transports. In modules C1-C4 final disposal or processing of products is covered. The main component is recycled paper, which is considered waste and doesn't carry the loads of paper production.

Module B is not included as the insulation material will not need maintenance during building's life span.

The production of production equipment and means of transport, as well as the machinery, equipment and premises (production goods) needed for production and in production are excluded from the scope of the assessment, as are the commuting of workers. The calculation of Module D is based on an assumption that all insulation material is incinerated to produce



district heat energy. The district heating energy is calculated based on the average emissions of district heat at the time of calculation in Finland.



Allocation

In the factory in Saarijärvi, also asphalt fiber is produced and some allocations were needed. Allocation of energy for the insulation material and asphalt fiber production was made according to estimation by the producer. The waste treatment was allocated based on the production amounts of asphalt fiber and insulation fiber.
